

Order of the Regulator No. 2022/E86

APPROVAL OF ENERGY CHARGE ADJUSTMENT

Pursuant to section 20 of the Electricity Act 2010 ('Act'), the Electric Power Corporation has sought approval from the Regulator to implement retail rates charged to electricity consumers for the provision of electricity services.

The Order sets out the approved changes in tariffs.

Order approving change in tariff per unit of electricity

1. Post-paid Consumers

The Electric Power Corporation is permitted to charge the following tariffs –

For domestic induction consumers:

A Customer Usage	Usage Charge	Debt Charge	Energy Charge	Total
All	0.11	0.00	0.52	0.63

The Electric Power Corporation is permitted to charge the following tariffs –

For non-domestic induction meter consumers

Customer Usage	Usage Charge	Debt Charge	Energy charge	Total
All	0.15	0.00	0.52	0.67

2. Pre-paid Consumers

The Electric Power Corporation is permitted to charge the following tariffs -

For domestic pre-paid consumers:

Customer Usage	Usage Charge	Debt Charge	Energy Charge	Total
1-50 kWh	0.00	0.00	0.52	0.52
51 and above	0.11	0.00	0.52	0.63

For non-domestic pre-paid consumers

Customer Usage	Usage Charge	Debt Charge	Energy charge	Total
All	0.11	0.00	0.52	0.63

Duration of the Order

This Order will expire on the earlier of –

- (a) the Regulator revoking this Order; or
- (b) the making of a new Order by the Regulator with respect to the tariffs, rates or charges for the provision of electricity services by the Electric Power Corporation.

Ongoing monitoring of electricity tariffs

In accordance with the Regulator’s functions under section 6 of the Act, the Regulator shall monitor the tariffs, rates or charges for the provision of electricity services by the Electric Power Corporation.

Effective date of the Order

In accordance with section 20(5) of the Act, the Electric Power Corporation shall not charge the above mentioned rates until such time when the Electric Power Corporation has notified consumers of the new tariffs.

This Order is effective retrospectively from the **1st day of February 2022**
