

**ORDER OF THE REGULATOR NO.2021/T01**

**Submission of Audited Financial Statements for determination of Digital TV tariff**

Pursuant to the Broadcasting Act 2010 (“Act”), the Regulator is empowered to regulate the broadcasting market and to make Orders in the course of implementing statutory duties under the Act.

This Order concerns the failure of the following broadcasters to supply by 31<sup>st</sup> May 2021 the necessary audited financial statements (statements) period ending 31<sup>st</sup> December 2020, to satisfy regulatory process and requirements for the determination of the Digital TV tariff.

Broadcasters in particular are:

1. Apia Broadcasting Limited (TV3); and
2. Kingdom TV.


The Regulator sees it fit to issue this Order in light of the above and subsequent to several correspondences from the Regulator inclusive of the following:

1. letter of 25<sup>th</sup> January 2021 to the Broadcasters for the submission of statements by 28<sup>th</sup> February 2021;
2. letter of 18<sup>th</sup> February 2021 reminding the Broadcasters regarding due date for submission of statements;
3. letter of 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2021 to Broadcasters extending due date for submission of statements to 30 April 2021;
4. letter of 21<sup>st</sup> April 2021 reminding the Broadcasters regarding the due date for submission of statements;
5. Letter of 21<sup>st</sup> May 2021 last and final extension on submission of statements to be due in 31<sup>st</sup> May 2021.

**Order**

Apia Broadcasting Limited (TV 3) and Kingdom TV must submit to the Office of the Regulator its audited financial statements ending 31<sup>st</sup> December 2020 no later than **5:00pm 16<sup>th</sup> June 2021**.

Failure to comply will result in instigating powers of the Regulator under the Act inclusive of revocation of license.
